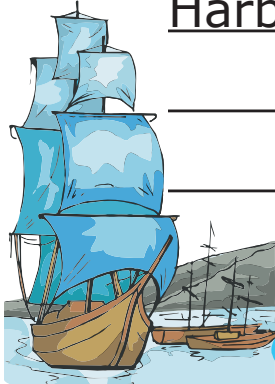

Plymouth to Plymouth Bodies of Water

River: a large stream of fresh water that flows into another river, lake, sea, or ocean.

Sound: a long narrow strip of water that connects two bodies of water.

Sea: a large body of salt water, partially or completely surrounded by land.

Ocean: one of the major bodies of salt water covering the earth.

Bay: a body of salt water enclosed on two or three sides by land, usually smaller than a sea.

Harbor: a sheltered body of water that allows a ship to anchor safely from rougher, deeper waters.
